This year's tournament is sure to be fun, and possibly even rewarding, with longest putt, drive and closest-to-the-pin contests – not to mention a chance to win a new car.

The Wichita Aero Club Golf Classic gives you the opportunity to play on the same pristinely manicured course at Crestview Country Club that the pros will play on the following week at the PGA Web.com Tour Wichita Air Capital Classic. You'll receive a new Nike golf shirt and other golf-related items at check-in, which begins at 10 AM, followed by a shotgun start at 11:30 AM. We'll play an always enjoyable and competitive scramble format. The 7th and 17th Holes will offer refreshing breaks at margarita stands and there will be opportunities on the



course for every golfer to win a new car with a hole in one on the Par 3 at Number 8, courtesy of Davis-Moore. There will also be a competition for a spot in the Scholarship Shootout—a new contest this year that will provide a lucrative cash prize to the winner and contribute an additional sum to the WAC Scholarship fund, as well. The qualifying round will take place as teams play #17 with the finalists taking part in the Shootout at # 18 during the 19th Hole Reception for a cash prize expected to be in the hundreds of dollars.

The Air Capital Classic Supports Charitable Organizations

The PGA TOUR, which owns the Web.com tour and controls the Air Capital Classic event and all of the Web.com tour stops, incorporates a strong charitable component into each of its events. Prominent PGA TOUR tournaments such as the U.S. OPEN, the Masters, and the PGA Championship donate significant funds to local and national charities as part of their annual activities. Now in its 27th year, the Air Capital Classic has a consistent history of supporting local organizations. Since 2006, The Air Capital Classic has contributed about \$1.5 million to local charities with many related to youth organizations and activities.



Wichita Aero Club Aviation Related Educational Initiatives

The Wichita Aero Club was founded with a commitment to foster and promote aviation education. That dedication includes the support of aviation-related training and career development, and offering scholarships and financial assistance to aviation-related institutions and students.

Proceeds from yearly Trophy Gala and Golf Classic events have allowed the Wichita Aero Club to establish a scholarship fund. Currently, the Wichita Aero Club and Wichita Community Foundation collaborate on the awarding of two scholarships: the Edward W. Stimpson Scholarship and the Dean Humphrey Scholarship. Both awards are designed for collegiate or technical school students who have already established an aviation-related major or career path. While the Stimpson scholarship targets students who may wish to pursue engineering or flight related careers, the Humphrey scholarship is designed to underwrite the educational pursuits of students who are seeking a career in administration, communication or non-technical disciplines at aviation-related businesses.

The Wichita Aero Club recently increased the amount of these scholarships and intends to increase the number and/or frequency of these awards as funding grows.
